This Collection of Selected Words contains more than 2,200 significant and commonly used Persian/Arabic words and phrases, with their corresponding English translation, that appear in the Baha'i Writings. The English translation of the Persian/Arabic word or phrase has been found by matching the words in the original Persian/ Arabic text with the same word or phrase in the published English translation of that same text. This method differs from consulting Persian to English or Arabic to English dictionaries to find the English equivalent of a Persian or Arabic word, taking advantage of the translator's research and insight in selecting the most appropriate translation for a particular context and meaning. In cases where the selected work has been translated by Shoghi Effendi, this method also enables us to follow the standard set by the

beloved Guardian in his translations of those works. Furthermore, this method enables one to find the translation of complete phrases not normally found in dictionaries; therefore, every attempt has been made to include such phrases and special terms in this collection. Although a relatively small number of texts has been used in preparing this collection, it is hoped that it will be useful in the general study of the Baha'i Writings in both Persian/Arabic and English. This work has 19 chapters, a section on verb conjugation, three appendices, and a bibliography. Numerous exercises, dialogues, texts, and special phrases are also provided. Each chapter consists of course texts, language notes, exercises, a vocabulary list, examples, and supplementary grammar. The texts focus on daily Tibetan life. Sentences are short and syntactically not overly complex. Exercises provide focus-related examples to reinforce chapter contents and include dialogues, sentences,

The intention of the writers is to concentrate on meaning, starting from the more general, everyday senses and building to an

understanding of theologically significant concepts. To avoid artificially restricting the focus of the articles, TDOT considers under each keyword the larger groups of words that are related linguistically or semantically. The lexical work includes detailed surveys of a word's occurrences, not only in biblical material but also in other ancient Near Eastern writings. Sumerian, Akkadian, Egyptian, Ethiopic, Ugaritic, and Northwest Semitic sources are surveyed, among others, as well as the Qumran texts and the Septuagint; and in cultures where no cognate word exists, the authors often consider cognate ideas. TDOT's emphasis, though, is on Hebrew terminology and on biblical usage. The contributors employ philology as well as form-critical and tradition-historical methods, with the aim of understanding the religious statements in the Old Testament. Extensive bibliographical information adds to the value of this reference work. This English edition attempts to serve the

needs of Old Testament students without the linguistic background of more advanced scholars; it does so, however, without sacrificing the needs of the latter. Ancient scripts (Hebrew, Greek, etc.) are regularly transliterated in a readable way, and meanings of foreign words are given in many cases where the meanings might be obvious to advanced scholars. Where the Hebrew text versification differs from that of English Bibles, the English verse appears in parentheses. Such features will help all earnest students of the Bible to avail themselves of the manifold theological insights contained in this monumental work. This book contains sixty Bible-inspired poems derived from Bible themes, character summaries, Bible-book summaries, and personal experiences, all laced with theology of God's grace towards our salvation.
