**The Fourth's 18%/15 Year Individual Retirement Account (IRA) Promotion** Mar 27 2023 The 18% interest rate was offered to capture as much of the 1982 IRA new account opening as possible. It applied only to the 1982 contribution (the maximum contribution was required to obtain this rate) and was available to the first 4,444 customers. An advertising campaign, shrouded in secrecy, began with two generic ads about IRAs. They ran as often as four times per evening per station from December 1-29. These ads educated applicants about IRAs and prepared them for the announcement of the 18% rate which was made in three ways: 1) a full-page ad; 2) the business reporter of the most-watched local television news station was allowed to tip the offering on the Monday 10pm news provided he highlight the newspaper ad; 3) the editor of the paper was briefed Monday noon on the offering, assuring news coverage on Tuesday as well as the advertisement; and 4) more than 1,300 mailgrams were delivered to physicians, dentists, and CPAs.

During his full term, Truman's relations with the news media became contentious over such matters as national security in the Cold War, the conduct of the Korean War, and the continuing charges of communism and corruption in the administration. Although Truman's career in politics was based on honesty and the welfare of the people, his early political alliance with Thomas Pendergast, Kansas City's notorious political boss, provided the opportunity for a portion of the press to charge Truman with subservience to Pendergast's own agenda of corrupt government. The history and the dynamics of the Truman presidency and the American news media, combined with biographical and institutional sketches of key individuals and news organizations, make *Harry S. Truman and the News Media* a captivating and original investigation of an American president.
