Summary: Wind-tunnel tests have been made in two-dimensional flow to investigate the aerodynamic characteristics of a double flap with an internal and an overhang balance. Three sizes of each type of balance were tested with three relative rates of deflection of the two flaps. An NACA 66-009 airfoil having a 0.30-airfoil-chord straight-contour forward flap and a 0.20-airfoil-chord straight-contour rearward flap was used. The test results indicated that a balanced double flap produced the same lift as a single plain flap of the same chord and also produced highly balanced hinge moments. High lifts and low hinge moments were obtained with a double-flap arrangement if either an overhang or an internal balance having a chord 50 percent of the flap chord was incorporated on the forward flap. The overhang-balance flap showed a lower value of the hinge-moment gradient due to flap deflection than the internally balanced flap.

H. R. 10650, Withholding on Dividends and Interest: Prepared for the Use of the Committee on Finance, United States Senate, by the Staff
The House bill provides that payors of interest, dividends, and patronage dividends are to withhold one-fifth or 20 percent of the payment they would otherwise make to the interest, dividend, or patronage dividend recipient, with certain exceptions. This withheld amount is to be paid over to the Government by the payor (sec. 3481) by the last day of the first month after the end of each quarter of the payor's taxable year (April 30, July 31, October 31, and January 31 for calendar year taxpayers). The recipient of the interest, dividend, or patronage dividend payment when he files his own income tax return can claim credit for the payment made by the payor on his behalf. This withholding system does not require the attachment of any receipt by the recipient of the payment to his tax return (sec. 3489 provides a presumption that amounts have been withheld). It also does not require the

payor to send the income recipient any receipt. Instead, it is presumed that, initially at least, payors will indicate in some communication to the recipient of the payment that the payment is "net," that is, reduced by one-fifth for the amount withheld for the Government. It is contemplated that the recipient of the payment on his tax return first will report the net interest, dividend, or patronage dividend payment received. He will then be requested to add to this amount one-fourth of the amount received, representing the amount withheld. This is what is referred to as "grossing up" the interest or dividend payment. Thus, for example, if an individual were entitled to \$100 of dividends before withholding, one-fifth of this amount, or \$20 would be withheld by the payor and remitted to the Government. The remaining \$80 would be the net dividend payment received by the recipient. This is the amount he would initially report on his income tax return. He would be asked to add to this amount one-fourth

of it, or \$20, bringing the total back to the full \$100 dividend payment. He would then compute his income tax in the usual manner. Finally, the tax otherwise owed would be reduced by the amount withheld with respect to this dividend, namely, \$20. Under the House bill, provision is made for exemptions from withholding in certain cases and also for quick refunds where no tax is owed or there is overwithholding. In addition, no withholding is provided in the case of certain types of interest and other payments. The withholding provisions generally are to be effective with respect to interest and dividend payments made after January 1, 1963. In the case of patronage dividends, the withholding provisions will apply to payments with respect to patronage occurring in the first taxable year of the cooperative beginning after January 1, 1963. Placebo and Pain Jan 23 2022 Complementary and alternative medicine (CAM) is frequently conceptualized as 'nothing but' placebo. I will argue, and provide the evidence in this chapter, that, apart from potential specific effects, CAM is a clever way of inducing generic self-healing effects. Jerome D Frank's model serves to conceptualize this. CAM practitioners normally establish good relationships and take time to listen to their patients. They have very elaborate rituals to enact those effects. They demonstrate their prowess and they provide alternative explanatory models that make sense, at least to those patients that consult with them. Most

important of all, perhaps, is the fact that nearly all CAM modalities require patients to become active, thus serving as a catalyst to mobilize resources and stimulate the experience of self-efficacy. The latter is debatedly one of the most important nonspecific effects of therapy. Hence, it is misleading to conceptualize CAM effects as nonspecific effects. Rather, it seems to be a way of activating a self-healing response that is very specific in itself, and indeed, more specific than purportedly specific pharmacologic effects.
